Every year at our annual symposium the OAS presents awards to a number of worthy individuals. While this might seem to some like some kind of arcane ritual born in the early days of our society, I would argue that the awards presentation is an important part of what the OAS does because it:

1. Encourages our younger, [student members to continue innovative research](#);
2. Rewards those members of our community who are working to an excellent standard, whether in the area of [CRM](#) or [Public Archaeology](#); and
3. Recognizes and honours those people who have made significant and on-going contributions to archaeology in Ontario whether those contributions are [academic](#) or in [service](#).

All of these things speak to our goals as a society. It currently sits at just under \$100 and we will face the need to cover the cost of awards from our operating funds.

Canada Helps, the organization that the OAS uses to help facilitate on-line donations, is holding a "Great Canadian Giving Challenge" during June. While we welcome donations all year around, of any amount, this month we are hoping to raise money specifically for our awards fund with the goal of restoring its financial health and enable us to continue providing these tangible expressions of appreciation to our deserving award winners.
