A Bibliography of Ontario Archaeology

INTRODUCTION

This bibliography is essentially a by-product of various research projects carried out by the Royal Ontario Museum. It does not pretend to complete coverage, for no attempt was made to track down the more obscure references. It is my hope, however, that most of the major ones to April, 1965, are included.

In assembling the bibliography, I have incorporated the work of earlier bibliographers without checking their sources or altering their format. This has introduced several inconsistencies in the form of the present text. While these formal inconsistencies may offend the purists, they should not hamper the research workers for whom this bibliography was assembled. Whenever possible, the references are given exactly as they appear on the publication and have not been codified into any standard format.

The abbreviations employed throughout should require no explanation, apart from the following: "Canadian Historical Review" has been reduced to C.H.R.; the series of archaeological reports which appears as an appendix to the Report of the Minister of Education, Ontario, is Listed as "A.A.R.O." (Annual Archaeological Report, Ontario) followed by the year of *publication*.
